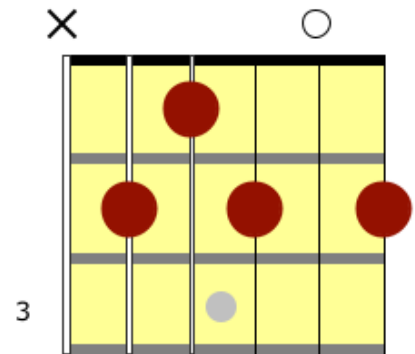
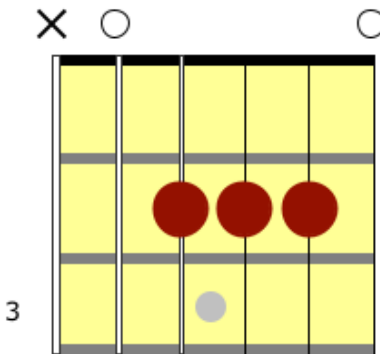
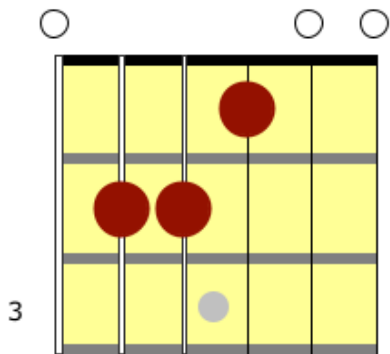

Basic Strum Pattern

Basic Strum Pattern for E and A chords.
